

VOCABULARY FOR 7, AUGUST 2018

1. INORDINATE (ADJECTIVE): (अत्यधिक): excessive

Synonyms: dizzying, exorbitant

Antonyms: moderate, reasonable

Example Sentence: Some dogs are very hyper and require an inordinate amount of attention from their owners.

2. INDIGENOUS (ADJECTIVE): (देशी): native

Synonyms: domestic, homegrown

Antonyms: alien, foreign

Example Sentence: Nothing beats fresh produce from the ground in its indigenous state.

3. INTERMITTENT (ADJECTIVE): (सविराम): irregular

Synonyms: fitful, infrequent

Antonyms: regular, frequent

Example Sentence: The holiday lights are intermittent and flicker on and off constantly.

4. INCESSANT (ADJECTIVE): (लगातार): ceaseless

Synonyms: endless, continuous

Antonyms: bounded, ceasing

Example Sentence: His hostility to Reva was incessant.

5. INSULAR (ADJECTIVE): (संकुचित विचारवाला): narrow-minded

Synonyms: circumscribed, parochial

Antonyms: broad-minded, unbiased

Example Sentence: Only a few people live in their insular neighborhood in the coldest part of Alaska.

6. JINX (NOUN): (अशुभ): curse

Synonyms: hex, hoodoo

Antonyms: boon, luck

Example Sentence: He regarded her as a jinx because she had lost her husband.

7. INERTIA (NOUN): (जड़ता): laziness

Synonyms: passivity, sluggishness

Antonyms: action, activity

Example Sentence: After a large meal, inertia usually keeps me on the couch all day.

8. IMMACULATE (ADJECTIVE): (शुद्ध): unspoiled

Synonyms: exquisite, neat

Antonyms: dull, defiled

Example Sentence: The soldier was reprimanded for ruining his immaculate uniform.

9. IMPUTE (VERB): (आरोप लगाना): attribute

Synonyms: accredit, assign

Antonyms: exonerate, exculpate

Example Sentence: Even though my sister had broken the window, she tried to impute the damage onto me.

10. INKLING (NOUN): (आभास): idea

Synonyms: clue, hunch

Antonyms: knowledge, information

Example Sentence: The records give us an inkling of how people saw the world.
