Newly rich consumers eager to flaunt their prosperity.

2.IMPUDENCE (NOUN): (बदतमीजी): impertinence**Synonyms:** insolence, effrontery**Antonyms:** pertinence**Example Sentence:**

His arrogance and impudence had offended many.

3.QUIESCENT (ADJECTIVE): (स्थिर): inactive**Synonyms:** inert, latent**Antonyms:** active**Example Sentence:**

Strikes were headed by groups of workers who had previously been quiescent.

4.PROFOUNDLY (ADVERB): (गंभीरतापूर्वक): extremely**Synonyms:** very, deeply**Antonyms:** superficially**Example Sentence:**

He profoundly altered the whole course of my life.

5.ABHORRENT (ADJECTIVE): (घिनौना): hateful**Synonyms:** detestable, detested**Antonyms:** admirable**Example Sentence:**

Racism is abhorrent to us all.

6.VOLATILE (ADJECTIVE): (अस्थिर): tense**Synonyms:** strained, fraught**Antonyms:** stable**Example Sentence:**

The political situation was becoming more volatile.

7.RETREAT (VERB): (पीछे हटना): go out**Synonyms:** ebb, recede**Antonyms:** come in**Example Sentence:**

It becomes so hot that the lizards retreat into the shade.

8.ENIGMATIC (ADJECTIVE): (रहस्यपूर्ण): enigmatic**Synonyms:** mysterious, confusing**Antonyms:** straightforward**Example Sentence:**

He found his boss's utterances too cryptic.

9.OPPRESSIVE (ADJECTIVE): (दमनकारी): harsh**Synonyms:** cruel, brutal**Antonyms:** lenient**Example Sentence:**

They survived an oppressive dictatorship.

10.SLENDER (ADJECTIVE): (अल्प): meagre**Synonyms:** limited, slight**Antonyms:** considerable**Example Sentence:**
