2. ULTIMATE (ADJECTIVE): (अंतिम): **eventual****Synonyms:** last, final**Antonyms:** immediate**Example Sentence:**

My team's ultimate aim was to delay his resignation.

3. ADVERSE (ADJECTIVE): (प्रतिकूल): **unfavourable****Synonyms:** disadvantageous, inauspicious**Antonyms:** favourable**Example Sentence:**

Taxes are having an adverse effect on production.

4. DIPLOMATIC (ADJECTIVE): (कूट-नीतिक): **tactful****Synonyms:** sensitive, subtle**Antonyms:** indiscreet, tactless**Example Sentence:**

He tried his best to be diplomatic.

5. EMBARGO (VERB): (निषेध करना): **ban****Synonyms:** bar, prohibit**Antonyms:** allow**Example Sentence:**

The documents of national security importance are routinely embargoed.

6. PROVOKE (VERB): (उकसाना): **goad****Synonyms:** spur prick**Antonyms:** deter**Example Sentence:**

A teacher can provoke you into working harder.

7. HALT (NOUN): (विराम): **stop****Synonyms:** standstill cessation**Antonyms:** start**Example Sentence:**

A halt in production lead to heavy losses.

8. OUTGOING (ADJECTIVE): (बहिर्गामी): **departing****Synonyms:** retiring, leaving**Antonyms:** incoming**Example Sentence:**

The outgoing PM is an inspiration for all.

9. ARDUOUS (ADJECTIVE): (दुर्भर): **onerous****Synonyms:** taxing, difficult**Antonyms:** easy**Example Sentence:**

He commenced an arduous journey.

10. SHELVE (VERB): (ढालना): **lay aside****Synonyms:** pigeonhole, stay**Antonyms:** carry out**Example Sentence:**

Plans to reopen the school have been shelved.
