Lack of accountability has corroded public respect for political leaders.

3. DENY (VERB): (अस्वीकार**करना): refuse****Synonyms:** turn down, reject**Antonyms:** accept**Example Sentence:**

The inquiry was denied access to intelligence sources.

4. BOOST (VERB): (बढ़ावा देना): improve**Synonyms:** raise, uplift**Antonyms:** decrease**Example Sentence:**

A lot of measures were taken to boost tourism.

5. SUSTAINABLE (ADJECTIVE):**(सतत): continual****Synonyms:** continuous, viable**Antonyms:** unsustainable**Example Sentence:**

Economic growth must be gradual and sustainable.

6. SPUR (NOUN): (प्रोत्साहन): stimulus**Synonyms:** incentive, encouragement**Antonyms:** disincentive**Example Sentence:**

Wars act as a spur to practical invention.

7. WRECK (VERB): (खराब करना): ruin**Synonyms:** spoil, disrupt**Antonyms:** facilitate**Example Sentence:**

An eye injury wrecked his chances of a professional career.
