Raj has a rather lackadaisical approach to his work.

**2. OBTUSE (ADJECTIVE): (मंद): stupid****Synonyms:** dull, slow-witted**Antonyms:** astute**Example Sentence:**

She wondered if the doctor was being deliberately obtuse.

**3. ELEVATION (NOUN):****(बढ़ावा): promotion****Synonyms:** upgrading, advancement**Antonyms:** demotion**Example Sentence:**

The color usually deepens toward zenith and also with the elevation of observer.

**4. CONTEMPORARY (ADJECTIVE):****(समकालीन): present****Synonyms:** modern, present-day**Antonyms:** old-fashioned, out of date**Example Sentence:**

The event was recorded by a contemporary historian.

**5. PROPONENT (NOUN):****(समर्थक): supporter****Synonyms:** upholder, exponent**Antonyms:** opponent**Example Sentence:**

He is a strong proponent of the free market and liberal trade policies.

**6. ADHERE (VERB): (पालन करना): abide by****Synonyms:** stick to, hold to**Antonyms:** flout, ignore**Example Sentence:**

All drivers must adhere to speed limits.

**7. COERCIVE (ADJECTIVE):****(बलपूर्वक): persistent****Synonyms:** insistent, pressing**Antonyms:** powerless**Example Sentence:**

The governor has a hereditary army for coercive purposes.

**8. INCONSPICUOUS (ADJECTIVE):****(अगोचर): unnoticeable****Synonyms:** unobtrusive, unremarkable**Antonyms:** conspicuous, noticeable**Example Sentence:**
