3.FACILITATE (VERB): (सुविधाजनक बनाना): **ease****Synonyms:** enable, assist**Antonyms:** impede**Example Sentence:**

Schools were located in the same campus to facilitate the sharing of resources.

4.OUTBREAK (NOUN): (प्रकोप): **eruption****Synonyms:** flare-up, upsurge**Antonyms:** pacification**Example Sentence:**
