2. CONSENSUS (NOUN):**(सहमति): agreement****Synonyms:** harmony, concord**Antonyms:** disagreement**Example Sentence:**

There is a growing consensus that the current regime has failed.

3. PALLIATIVE (ADJECTIVE): (पीड़ा**हटानेवाला): soothing****Synonyms:** alleviating sedative**Antonyms:** intensifying**Example Sentence:**

Travel is like a palliative against depression for him.

4. CONVALESCENT (ADJECTIVE): (अच्छा**हो जानेवाला): recuperating****Synonyms:** recovering improving**Antonyms:** faltering**Example Sentence:**

Right-wing extremists created trouble.

7. SCEPTICISM (NOUN): (संदेहवाद): doubt**Synonyms:** disbelief, distrust**Antonyms:** conviction**Example Sentence:**

There was some scepticism in the claims.
