Social inequality is now on its peak.

**8. INTEGRITY (NOUN): (अखंडता): Unity****Synonyms:** Unification, Wholeness**Antonyms:** Division**Example Sentence:**

The PM upholds territorial integrity and national sovereignty.

**9. BRUTAL (ADJECTIVE): (क्रूर): Savage****Synonyms:** Cruel, Bloodthirsty**Antonyms:** Gentle**Example Sentence:**
