He will be extradited from the U.S. to Canada to face criminal charges there.

2. URGE (VERB): (आग्रह करता हूँ): **encourage****Synonyms:** enjoin, adjure**Antonyms:** discourage**Example Sentence:**

Drawing up outside the house, he urged her inside.

3. PERVERSE (ADJECTIVE): (विकृतिग्रस्त): **awkward****Synonyms:** contrary, difficult**Antonyms:** accommodating**Example Sentence:**

Kate's perverse decision not to cooperate held good.

4. APPEASE (VERB): (शांत करना): **conciliate****Synonyms:** placate, pacify**Antonyms:** provoke**Example Sentence:**

Amendments have been added to appease local pressure groups.

5. DISSIPATE (VERB): (गायब हो जाना): **disappear****Synonyms:** vanish evaporate**Antonyms:** grow**Example Sentence:**

The concern she'd felt for him had wholly dissipated.

6. TRIAL (NOUN): (परीक्षण): **test****Synonyms:** try-out, experiment**Antonyms:** proven**Example Sentence:**

Clinical trials must verify the truth.

7. BIZARRE (ADJECTIVE): (विचित्र): **strange****Synonyms:** peculiar, odd**Antonyms:** ordinary**Example Sentence:**

We had to face a bizarre situation.

8. CAMARADERIE (NOUN): (सौहार्द): **friendship****Synonyms:** comradeship fellowship,**Antonyms:** solitude**Example Sentence:**

Our camaraderie is evident to everyone.

9. CERTAINTY (NOUN): (निश्चय): **confidence****Synonyms:** conviction, certitude**Antonyms:** uncertainty**Example Sentence:**

She knew with certainty that he is dead.

10. PREVALENCE (NOUN): (प्रसार): **currency****Synonyms:** generality, pervasiveness**Antonyms:** infrequency**Example Sentence:**
