There is too much disquiet about animal testing.

2. PROFOUND (ADJECTIVE):**(गहन): heartfelt****Synonyms:** intense, keen**Antonyms:** superficial**Example Sentence:**

Profound feelings of sadness surrounded us all.

3. PERSPICACITY (NOUN):**(चतुराई): shrewdness****Synonyms:** discernment, perception**Antonyms:** stupidity**Example Sentence:**

The perspicacity of her remarks was quite evident.

4. DISINTERESTED (ADJECTIVE):**(निष्पक्ष): unbiased****Synonyms:** unprejudiced, impartial**Antonyms:** biased**Example Sentence:**

A banker is under an obligation to give disinterested advice.

5. MODERATE (ADJECTIVE):**(मध्यम): average****Synonyms:** modest, medium**Antonyms:** great**Example Sentence:**

Both of us walked at a moderate pace only.
