2. FISHY (ADJECTIVE):**(संदेहजनक): dubious****Synonyms:** doubtful, suspicious**Antonyms:** truthful, aboveboard**Example Sentence:**

I am convinced there is something fishy going on.

3. FORBEARANCE (NOUN):**(सहनशीलता): patient self-control****Synonyms:** tolerance, patience**Antonyms:** impatience**Example Sentence:**

His unflinching courtesy and forbearance under great provocation.

4. NASCENT (ADJECTIVE):**(नवजात): budding****Synonyms:** growing, developing**Antonyms:** developed, mature**Example Sentence:**

The Indian space industry is nascent at the moment.

5. VERBOSE (ADJECTIVE):**(वाचाल): wordy****Synonyms:** gabby, circumlocutory**Antonyms:** concise, succinct**Example Sentence:**

He is a verbose man.
