Fish furnish an important source of protein.

**3.TRANSIT (NOUN):****(पारवहन): movement****Synonyms:** transport, transportation**Antonyms:** hold, stagnation**Example Sentence:**

A painting was damaged in transit.

**4.ENTANGLE (VERB):****(उलझाना): intertwine****Synonyms:** entwine, tangle**Antonyms:** disentangle**Example Sentence:**

The fish tries to swim in the net and gets entangled

**5. RETRACT (VERB): (वापस लेना): pull****in****Synonyms:** draw in, pull back**Antonyms:** extend**Example Sentence:**

She retracted her hand as if she'd been burnt.

**6.APACE (ADVERB): (झटपट): quickly****Synonyms:** fast, swiftly**Antonyms:** slowly**Example Sentence:**

Work always continues apace.

**7.BRUNT (ADJECTIVE):****(आघात): impact****Synonyms:** force, shock**Antonyms:** resistance, endurance**Example Sentence:**

Education will bear the brunt of the cuts.

**8.STULTIFY (VERB): (उबा देना): bore****Synonyms:** stupefy weary**Antonyms:** interest, entertain**Example Sentence:**

She is too polite to bore us with anecdotes.
