I am convinced there is something fishy going on.

2. RECUMBENT (NOUN): (समतल): flat**Synonyms:** lying, horizontal**Antonyms:** erect, standing**Example Sentence:**

They are not recumbent, and the hair falling from the head is curled.

3. KNAVE (NOUN): (दुष्ट): fraud**Synonyms:** miscreant, rogue**Antonyms:** hero, angel**Example Sentence:**

He is known as a notorious knave of this area.

4. LUDICROUS (ADJECTIVE):**(ऊटपटांग): absurd****Synonyms:** bizarre, comical**Antonyms:** normal, ordinary**Example Sentence:**

It was a ludicrous statement made by her.

5. KUDOS (NOUN): (प्रशंसा): praise**Synonyms:** esteem, applause**Antonyms:** dishonour, denunciation**Example Sentence:**

When the football team won the state championship, they were given kudos during a celebratory pep rally.

6. SCRAMBLE (VERB): (अव्यवस्थित करना): disarrange**Synonyms:** muddle, confuse**Antonyms:** organize, align**Example Sentence:**

Maybe the alcohol scrambled his brains.

7. CULMINATION (NOUN):**(परिणति): climax****Synonyms:** peak, pinnacle**Antonyms:** nadir**Example Sentence:**

The deal marked the culmination of years of negotiation.

8. KNOTTY (ADJECTIVE):**(जटिल): troublesome****Synonyms:** mystifying, perplexing**Antonyms:** easy, facile**Example Sentence:**

It was his knotty idea.

9. CODIFY (VERB): (संहिताबद्ध**करना): organize****Synonyms:** systematize, arrange**Antonyms:** expunge, abrogate**Example Sentence:**

The statutes have codified certain branches of common law.
