Synonyms: Reciprocate , Counter-attack	Synonyms: Verge , Border
Antonyms: Forgive , Sympathize	Antonyms: Middle , Centre
Example Sentence: He insulted people who could be guaranteed to retaliate hurtfully.	Example Sentence: This woman could bring me to the brink of insanity.
4-Undeterred(Adjective): व्याकुल: Not discouraged or dissuaded	9-Wreaked(Verb) : टूट पड़ा: Cause very great harm or damage
