

VOCABULARY FOR 10 NOVEMBER 2022

1-Lobbyists(Noun) : प्रचारक: Someone who tries to persuade a politician or official group to do something

Synonyms: Activist , Powerbroker

Antonyms: Repress , Dissuade

Example Sentence: This is simply powerful lobbyists trying to influence the Government.

2-Converge(Verb): मलना : Move towards a place from different directions and meet

Synonyms: Intersect , Connect

Antonyms: Disperse , Scatter

Example Sentence: Students converged in the parking lot to say goodbye after graduation.

3-Catastrophic(Adjective):

आप तजनक: Sudden and widespread disaster

Synonyms: Disastrous , Devastating

Antonyms: Fortunate , Blesses

Example Sentence: The water shortage in this country is potentially catastrophic.

4-Lofty(Adjective): बुलंद : A haughty overbearing manner

Synonyms: Supercilious , Towering

Antonyms: Stumpy , short

Example Sentence: She showed a lofty disregard for their objections.

5-Wrangling(verb) : तकरार : To argue, often in a noisy or angry way

Synonyms: Squabble , Debate

Antonyms: Praise , Kindness

Example Sentence: We don't believe in a long legal wrangle.

6-Reeling(Verb) : लड़खड़ाना : Walk or move unsteadily.

Synonyms: Stagger , Stumble

Antonyms: Aware , Clear

Example Sentence: She hit him so hard that he reeled backwards.

7-Strides(Verb) : प्रगति : progress towards a goal.

Synonyms: Tramp , Clump

Antonyms: Recess , Regress

Example Sentence: They were joined by a newcomer who came striding across a field.

8-Slid(Verb) : गरावट : Move smoothly/quietly

Synonyms: Slip Trickle

Antonyms: Ascend , Retard

Example Sentence: He slid a coin into her hand.

9.CESSATION (NOUN): (ठहराव): abeyance

Synonyms: breather, discontinuance

Antonyms: activity, continuity

Example Sentence: Since the bad weather has caused a temporary building cessation, the office building will not be completed on time.

10.LATENT (ADJECTIVE):

(निष्क्रिय): dormant

Synonyms: quiescent, inactive

Antonyms: manifest

Example Sentence: They have a huge reserve of latent talent.
