| <b>Antonyms:</b> Constant , Frequent  |
| <b>Example Sentence:</b> The president returned the country to prosperity during his epochal terms in office. |
| <b>5-Transition(Noun) : संक्रमण : A change or shift from one state, subject, place, etc. to another.</b>      |
| <b>Synonyms :</b> Conversion , Alteration   |
| <b>Antonyms :</b> Idleness , Sameness   |
| <b>Example Sentence::</b> The transition to a multi-party democracy is proving to be difficult.               |

| <b>Synonyms:</b> Mutual , Two-Side.   |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> Multilateral , Unilateral  |
