1.ZEALOUS (ADJECTIVE): (उत्साही): fervent
Synonyms: ardent, fervid
Antonyms: apathetic
Example Sentence: The council was extremely zealous in the application of the regulations.
2.DISPUTE (VERB): (विवाद करना): challenge
Synonyms: contest, deny
Antonyms: accept
Example Sentence: The accusations on him are entirely disputed.
3.MARGINAL (ADJECTIVE): (थोड़ा): slight
Synonyms: small, tiny
Antonyms: vast
Example Sentence: It seems likely to make only a marginal difference.
4. SEVERELY (ADVERB): (गंभीर रूप से): seriously
Synonyms: gravely, critically
Antonyms: slightly
Example Sentence: Our business has been severely affected by the slowdown.
5. QUIESCENT (ADJECTIVE): (स्थिर): inactive
Synonyms: inert, latent
Antonyms: active
Example Sentence: Strikes were headed by groups of workers who had previously been quiescent.

6.TIRESOME (ADJECTIVE): (थकानेवाला): boring
Synonyms: dull, tedious
Antonyms: interesting
Example Sentence: Weeding is a tiresome but essential job.
7.AUGMENT (VERB): (बढ़ाना): increase
Synonyms: add to, supplement
Antonyms: decrease
Example Sentence: He augmented his summer income by painting.
8. RIFE (ADJECTIVE): (ब्याप्त): widespread
Synonyms: general common
Antonyms: scarce
Example Sentence: Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.
9.CONSEQUENTIAL (ADJECTIVE): (अहम): resulting
Synonyms: resultant, ensuing
Antonyms: casual
Example Sentence: A loss of confidence and a consequential withdrawal of funds.
10.GLOSSY (ADJECTIVE): (सतही आकर्षक): expensive
Synonyms: high-quality, stylish
Antonyms: cheap
Example Sentence: That is just another glossy TV miniseries
