2-Spike(Noun) : नोकदार चीज़ : A piece of metal, wood, etc. that has a sharp point at one end

Synonyms: Nail, Pin

Example Sentence: The top of the wall was lined with broken glass and steel spikes to keep people from climbing over.

3-Mortuaries(Noun) : शवगृह : A place in which dead bodies are kept until burial.

Synonyms: Morgue , Crematory

Example Sentence: She was laid out in the mortuary

4-Containment(Noun) : नियंत्रण: The act, process, or means of keeping something within limits.

Synonyms: Confinement , Isolation

Antonyms: Indiscipline, Chaos

Example Sentence: The government needs to adopt a containment strategy.

5-Swathe(Verb) : लपेटना : To bind, wrap, or swaddle with or as if with a bandage

Synonyms: Enfold, Drape **Antonyms:** Untile, Unbind

Example Sentence: The nurse swathed the wounded soldier's leg in bandages.

6-Reverberate(Verb) : (ध्वनि का) गूँजना : (of sound)To continue to be

heard; to echo repeatedly

Synonyms: Resonate, Vibrate

Example Sentence: The loud music reverberated off the walls.

7-Inevitable(Adjective):

अनिवार्य : Certain to happen and unable

to be avoided or prevented

Synonyms: Inescapable , Inexorable

Antonyms: Avoidable, uncertain

Example Sentence: The accident was

the inevitable

consequence/result/outcome of carelessness.

8-Fait : भाषा-संबंधी : Consisting of or related to language.

Example Sentence:: These ideas rapidly became the new orthodoxy in linguistics...

9-Efficacious(Adjective):

प्रभावशाली : Capable of having the

desired result or effect

Synonyms: Effective , Productive **Antonyms:** Impotent , Incapable

Example Sentence: They resort to any and every agent which has been proved efficacious, whether it be vegetable or mineral.

10-Curbs(Verb) : नियंत्रण रखना : To limit or control something, especially something bad

Synonyms: Limitation , Restrain

Antonyms: Loosen, Liberate

Example Sentence: You must curb your

extravagant tastes.
