1-Sparse(Adjective) : कम घना : Small in number or amount and spread out over an area.	Example Sentence: They were concerned only with their own religious fervor.
Synonyms: Meagre , Scanty	7-Fatigue(Noun) : थकान : Extreme tiredness
Antonyms : Abundant , Plentiful	Synonyms : Drowsiness , Weariness
Example Sentence: Many slopes are rock fields with sparse vegetation.	Antonyms : Vigorous
2-A foot : Being planned or prepared	Example Sentence: She continued to have severe stomach cramps, aches, fatigue, and depression.
Synonyms : Forthcoming	8-Bolstered(Verb) : सहारा देना : To support or encourage somebody/something
Example Sentence: In a quiet country backwater, something evil is afoot.	Synonyms : Strengthened , Boost
3-Convergence(Noun) : अभिसरण : The fact that two or more things, ideas, etc. become similar or come together	Antonyms : Opposed , Discourage
Synonyms : Assemble , Confluence	Example Sentence: The IAF said that there was a need for India to bolster its "technological asymmetry."
Antonyms : Divergent	9-Tenable(Adjective) : मान्य : Reasonable and could be successfully defended against criticism
Example Sentence: Economic forces converged to bring the country out of a recession.	Synonyms: Justifiable , Plausible
4-Vanguards(Noun) : अग्र-दल : The forefront of an action or movement	Antonyms : Irrational
Synonyms: Avant-garde	Example Sentence: His theory is no longer tenable in the light of the recent discoveries.
Example Sentence: The company is proud to be in the vanguard of scientific progress.	10-Complacency(Noun) : शालीनता , आत्मसंतोष : Self-satisfaction especially when accompanied by unawareness of actual dangers or deficiencies
5-Buoyancy(Noun) : अधिक उछाल : Power to float or rise in a fluid; relative lightness	Synonyms: Comfort , Ease
Synonyms : Ebullience , Vivacity	Antonyms : Humility , Diffidence
Antonyms : Inadequacy , Helplessness	Example Sentence: This boundless complacency was due to policy, not weakness.
Example Sentence: She was in a buoyant mood and they were looking forward to their new life.	
6-Fervor(Noun) : उत्साह : Very strong feeling or belief	
Synonyms : Ardor , Passion	
Antonyms : Apathy , Dullness
