1-Glimmer(Verb) : झिलमिलाना : (of light) to shine without strength or not continuously	Synonyms : Clamp , Grasp
Synonyms : Glean , Glow	Antonyms : Loosen , Release
Antonyms : Dim	Example Sentence : The child clutched her mother's hand firmly.
Example Sentence : A candle glimmered faintly in the darkened room.	7-Contend(Verb): संघर्ष करना : To struggle in opposition
2-Seeking(Verb) : माँगना , ढूँढना : To search for something or try to find or obtain something	Synonyms : Struggle , Protest
Synonyms : Exploring , Searching	Antonyms : Peaceful , Agreeable
Example Sentence : Employers are seeking further clarification of the proposals.	Example Sentence : The team is expected to contend for the championship this year.
3-Petitioners(Noun) : प्रार्थी : A person who brings a legal case to a court of law	8-Decennial(Adjective) : दस वर्ष का: Recurring every ten years.
Synonyms : Appellant , Applicant	Synonyms : Decaversary
Example Sentence : The judge awarded the costs of the case to the petitioners.	Example Sentence : For the 2000 decennial census, that will no longer be the case.
4-Ambit(Noun) : दायरा: The range or limits of the influence of something	9-Disparity(Noun) : असमानता : A difference, especially one that is caused by unfair treatment
Synonyms : Bounds , Extent	Synonyms : Discrepancy , Distinction
Example Sentence : They believe that all the outstanding issues should fall within the ambit of the talks.	Antonyms : Parity , Similarity
5-Decriminalize (Verb) : To stop something from being illegal	Example Sentence : There are also big disparities in pay.
Example Sentence : He could insist that the military either legalize or decriminalize adultery	10-Purported : विकट: (used about a situation, news, etc.) unpleasant or worrying
6-Clutch(Verb) : पकड़ना: To take or try to take hold of something tightly, usually in fear, worry, or pain	Synonyms : Stern , Aloof
	Antonyms : Amiable
