

**VOCABULARY FOR 23 JANUARY 2023**

<b>1. Elusive (Adjective) : हाथ ना आनेवाला: difficult to find, catch, or achieve</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> evasive, transient, fleeting
<b>Antonyms:</b> attainable, available, convenient
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Since I am not very good at math, earning an "A" in geometry is an elusive goal for me.
<b>2. Stringent (Adjective): कठोर: strict, precise, and exacting (of regulations, requirements, or conditions)</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> strict, rigorous, rigid
<b>Antonyms:</b> lenient, flexible,
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The quantity of exports has declined since the early 80s due to the stringent procedures by the government.
<b>3. Impregnable (Adjective) : अजेय: incapable of being overcome, challenged, or defeated</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> invincible, invulnerable, unconquerable
<b>Antonyms:</b> susceptible, vulnerable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The prison's impregnable security wall makes it impossible for inmates to leave the grounds.
<b>4. Salvo (Noun) : धमाका: a simultaneous discharge of two or more guns in military action ; a sudden, vigorous, or aggressive act</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> barrage, flurry
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The soldier loaded his gun in order to complete the salvo.
<b>5. Collegium (Noun): a group in which each member has approximately equal power and authority.</b>
<b>Example Sentence:</b> In total there were 27 members of the Collegium in 1990.
<b>6. Fulmination (Noun) : विस्फोट: an expression of vehement protest ; a violent explosion or a flash like lightning</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> protest, objection

<b>Example Sentence:</b> At the town hall meeting, residents began to fulminate over the proposed tax increase
<b>7. Fruition (Noun) : सफलता: the realization or fulfillment of a plan or project</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> accomplishment, fulfillment, attainment
<b>Antonyms:</b> nought, failure, inception
<b>Example Sentence:</b> After much delay, the plan to build the new hospital finally came to fruition.
<b>8. Delegitimise (Verb): अमान्य: withdraw legitimate status or authority ; to make something seem not valid or not acceptable</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> invalidate, nullify, proscribe
<b>Antonyms:</b> legitimize, sanction
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The government's tactics have been to delegitimize the voices of the poor.
<b>9. Euthanasia (Noun) : इच्छामृत्यु: the painless killing of a patient suffering from an incurable and painful disease or in an irreversible coma.</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> killing, slaughter
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He asked if we had considered euthanasia, since the cat's care would require a considerable amount over \$100, and "he might end up with only three legs".
<b>10. Erroneous (Adjective) : गलत: wrong; incorrect</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> false, misleading
<b>Antonyms:</b> accurate, valid, true
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Some people have the erroneous notion that one can contract AIDS by giving blood.
