<p>1. Adherence (Noun) : निष्ठा / पालन: the fact of someone behaving exactly according to rules, beliefs, etc</p> <p>Synonyms: compliance, obedience, accordance</p> <p>Antonyms: breach, infringement, violation,</p> <p>Example Sentence: The teacher demanded the students' adherence to the rules while in her classroom.</p>	<p>6. Imperialism (Noun) : साम्राज्यवाद: a policy of extending a country's power and influence through colonization, use of military force, or other means</p> <p>Synonyms: colonialism, domination, expansionism</p> <p>Example Sentence: It has been said that the deepest impulse of British imperialism has been to extend English ways of thought throughout the world.</p>
<p>2. Emblematic (Adjective): serving as a symbol of a particular quality or concept; symbolic.</p> <p>Synonyms: symbolic, representative, metaphoric, figurative,</p> <p>Antonyms: realistic, actual, literal</p> <p>Example Sentence: The killing in Pensacola is emblematic of a lot of the violence that is happening around the world.</p>	<p>7. Vigil (Noun) : निगरानी: a period of keeping awake during the time usually spent asleep, especially to keep watch or pray</p> <p>Synonyms: watch, surveillance, lookout, observation, inspection</p> <p>Antonyms: ignorance, indifference, neglect</p> <p>Example Sentence: Eva and Paul kept a constant vigil by their daughter's hospital bedside</p>
<p>3. Pluralism (Noun): the existence of different types of people, who have different beliefs and opinions, within the same society</p> <p>Synonyms: diversity, heterogeneity, multiplicity, variety</p> <p>Antonyms: uniformity, similarity, consistency, sameness</p> <p>Example Sentence: We know it's not easy to maintain the pluralism.</p>	<p>8. Prudence (Noun) : सावधान: behavior that is careful and avoids risks</p> <p>Synonyms: caution, circumspection, care</p> <p>Antonyms: recklessness, brashness, carelessness</p> <p>Example Sentence: The captain said we ought to shorten sail anyway, out of common prudence.</p>
<p>4. Etch (Adjective) : नक्काशी: engrave (metal, glass, or stone) by coating it with a protective layer, drawing on it with a needle,</p> <p>Synonyms: engrave, carve, inscribe, sculpt, trace</p> <p>Antonyms: erase, obliterate, expunge</p> <p>Example Sentence: He etched his name on a piece of glass.</p>	<p>9. Flounder (Verb): to experience great difficulties or be completely unable to decide what to do or say next</p> <p>Synonyms: struggle, stumble, limp, lurch</p> <p>Example Sentence: After it hit the iceberg, the Titanic was left to flounder in the Atlantic Ocean before it finally sank.</p>
<p>5. Amalgamation (Noun) : एकीकरण: the action, process, or result of combining or uniting</p> <p>Synonyms: combination, union, fusion</p> <p>Antonyms: division, separation, split, partition,</p> <p>Example Sentence: I think it's this amalgamation of fact, fiction, and potential which made it such a great story.</p>	<p>10. Vociferous (Adjective) : शोरगुलपूर्ण: expressing or characterized by vehement opinions; loud and forceful</p> <p>Synonyms: outspoken, vocal, blatant</p> <p>Antonyms: silent, quiet, still</p> <p>Example Sentence: The protestors were vociferous as they screamed outside of the government building.</p>
