

## VOCABULARY FOR 31 JANUARY 2023

### 1. QUESTIONABLE (ADJECTIVE):

(शंकास्पद): **controversial**

**Synonyms:** contentious, doubt

**Antonyms:** certain

**Example Sentence:** It is questionable whether any of these exceptions is genuine.

### 2. ABSOLVE (VERB): (दोषमुक्त करना): **exonerate**

**Synonyms:** discharge, acquit

**Antonyms:** blame

**Example Sentence:** The pardon absolved them of all the crimes.

### 3. CHOPPY (ADJECTIVE):

(अशांत): **rough**

**Synonyms:** turbulent, heavy

**Antonyms:** calm

**Example Sentence:** Sea conditions are often very choppy.

### 4. DISTORT (VERB):

(बिगाड़ना): **twist**

**Synonyms:** misrepresent, pervert

**Antonyms:** accurate

**Example Sentence:** Many facts in the newspaper were distorted.

### 5. RESOLUTE (ADJECTIVE):

(दृढ़): **determined**

**Synonyms:** purposeful, purposive

**Antonyms:** irresolute

**Example Sentence:** She was resolute and unswerving.

### 6. BIZARRE (ADJECTIVE):

(विचित्र): **strange**

**Synonyms:** peculiar, odd

**Antonyms:** ordinary

**Example Sentence:** I can't believe we're getting involved in something so bizarre.

### 7. RELEGATE (VERB): (नीचा दिखाना): **downgrade**

**Synonyms:** lower, put down

**Antonyms:** upgrade

**Example Sentence:** They aim to prevent women from being relegated to a secondary role.

### 8. RELIABLE (ADJECTIVE):

(विश्वसनीय): **dependable**

**Synonyms:** good, well founded

**Antonyms:** unreliable

**Example Sentence:** Newspapers are no more a reliable source of information.

### 9. INVOKE (VERB): (आह्वान करना): **cite**

**Synonyms:** adduce, instance

**Antonyms:** waive

**Example Sentence:** The antiquated defence of insanity is rarely invoked in England.

### 10. EXTREMISM (NOUN):

(अतिवाद): **fanaticism**

**Synonyms:** radicalism, zealotry

**Antonyms:** moderation

**Example Sentence:** The dangers of racist extremism are present everywhere.
