1. EXPEDITE : (VERB): (जल्दी करना) : speed up
Synonyms: accelerate, hurry
Antonyms: delay
Example Sentence: I expedited the completion of my report.
2. DISPEL : (VERB): (दूर करना) : banish
Synonyms: eliminate, dismiss
Antonyms: engender
Example Sentence: The brightness of the day did nothing to dispel my sadness.
3. FIERCE : (ADJECTIVE): (प्रचंड) : powerful
Synonyms: strong, violent
Antonyms: gentle
Example Sentence: Fierce storms lashed the country.
4. DISMAY : (NOUN): (त्रस्त करना) : appal
Synonyms: horrify, shock
Antonyms: encourage
Example Sentence: He was dismayed by the U-turn in policy.
5. IMPULSE : (NOUN): (आवेग) : wildness
Synonyms: spontaneity, recklessness
Antonyms: premeditation
Example Sentence: She was solely a woman of impulse.

6. AGITATION : (NOUN): (व्याकुलता) : anxiety
Synonyms: perturbation, disquiet
Antonyms: calmness
Example Sentence: She was wringing her hands in agitation.
7. ENTIRETY : (NOUN): (संपूर्णता) : whole
Synonyms: sum, total
Antonyms: part
Example Sentence: She would have to stay in her room for the entirety of the weekend.
8. DREAD : (NOUN): (भय) : fear
Synonyms: apprehension, trepidation
Antonyms: confidence
Example Sentence: The thought of returning to London filled her with dread.
9. AGGRIEVED (ADJECTIVE): (क्रोधित) : resentful
Synonyms: affronted, indignant
Antonyms: pleased
Example Sentence: They were aggrieved at the outcome.
10. SHAMBLE (VERB): (फेर-बदल करना) : shuffle
Synonyms: lumber, totter
Antonyms: run
Example Sentence: He shambled off down the corridor.
