| <b>4-Undeterred(Adjective): व्याकुल: Not discouraged or dissuaded</b>                               |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> Gritty , Bold  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> Timid , Nervous  |
| <b>Example Sentence::</b> Undeterred by his early failures, he decided to keep writing.             |
| <b>5-Stalled(Verb): अवरुद्ध : Stuck or not moving</b>   |
| <b>Synonyms:</b> Obstruct , Impede  |
| <b>Antonyms:</b> Hastened , Hurried   |
| <b>Example Sentence::</b> I stalled the car twice during my driving test but still managed to pass. |
