

**VOCABULARY FOR 10 FEBRUARY 2023****1-NATIVE (ADJECTIVE):****(जन्मजात) : Innate****Synonyms:** Inherent, Inborn**Antonyms:** Acquired**Example Sentence:** She has some last vestige of native wit.**2-Slashed(Verb) :** बहुत ज्यादा कटौती करना : **To reduce an amount of money, etc. very much****Synonyms:** Slice , Mangled**Example Sentence:** She stepped away to slash at a guardsman then tugged the necklace on quickly.**3-Perceptible(Adjective) :** प्रत्यक्ष : **That can be seen, heard, felt, tasted, smelled, or noticed****Synonyms :** Noticeable , Observable**Example Sentence:** When my father became angry, there was a perceptible change in his facial expression.**4-Deft(Adjective) :** निपुण : **Skilful, clever, or quick****Synonyms:** Adept , Adroit**Antonyms :** Crude , Clumsy**Example Sentence:** She answered the journalist's questions with a deft touch.**5-Grappled(Verb) :** हाथापाई करना : **To hold someone while fighting with him or her****Synonyms:** Confront**Antonyms :** Release**Example Sentence:** He briefly grappled with the police officer.**6-Migrants(Noun) :** प्रवासियों : **A person who moves from place to place looking for work****Synonyms :** Emigrant**Antonyms :** Resident**Example Sentence:** The government revoked her husband's license to operate migrant labor crews.**7-Integrity(Noun) :** ईमानदारी: **Quality of being honest and having strong moral principles****Synonyms :** Uprightness , Probity**Antonyms :** Dishonesty**Example Sentence:** They are trying to preserve the cultural integrity of the community.**8-Eroding(Verb) :** खत्म करना : **To diminish or destroy by degrees****Synonyms :** Ruining , Collapsing**Antonyms :** Restoring , Reviving**Example Sentence:** Wind and rain have eroded the statues into shapeless lumps of stone.**9-Scepticism(Noun):** अविश्वास : **Doubt that something is true or useful****Synonyms :** Misbelief , Cynicism**Antonyms :** Belief**Example Sentence:** First, you must rid yourself of self-doubt and skepticism.**10-Ramifications(Noun) :** असर : **Possible result of a decision or action****Synonyms:** Consequence , Outcome**Example Sentence:** The unexpected ramification made the buyers hesitant about signing the lease.
