<p><b>1. Tranche (Noun): अंश : a portion of something, especially money</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> segment, piece, chunk, section, lump, portion, fragment</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> whole</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> At the end of the month, a tranche of the worker's settlement will be sent from one account to a savings account.</p>	<p><b>6. Resounding (Adjective) : शानदार : experiencing pleasure, satisfaction, or delight</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> delight, joyful</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> sad, unhappy, joyless</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> The astronaut was welcomed with joyous, resounding acclaim.</p>
<p><b>2. Pursuance (Adjective) : the carrying out of a plan or action</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> implementation, carrying out, fulfilment</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> non-performance, nonfulfillment</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> They may need to borrow money in pursuance of their legal action.</p>	<p><b>7. Heft (Adjective) : बलवान : large, heavy, and powerful.</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> burly, heavy, sturdy</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> weakness, helplessness, impotence</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> Some synthetic fabrics are nice and warm, but I prefer wool because it has more heft.</p>
<p><b>3. Frazzled (Adjective): थका हुआ : completely exhausted</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> exhausted, fatigue</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> refreshed, energized</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> The meeting left me feeling completely frazzled</p>	<p><b>8. Enumerate : सूची बनाना : the action of mentioning a number of things one by one;</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> numbering, computation</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> randomize</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> Before the judge began to enumerate the charges against Harry, he asked to speak privately with the prosecutor.</p>
<p><b>4. Acquit (Verb) : बरी करना : free (someone) from a criminal charge by a verdict of not guilty.</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> absolve, clear, exonerate</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> incriminate, indict, convict</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> He has never failed to acquit a client charged with murder.</p>	<p><b>9. Receptive (Adjective): ग्रहणशील : willing to consider or accept new suggestions and ideas.</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> open-minded, broad-minded, impartial</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> unreceptive, partial</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> Children are more receptive to new experiences if their parents prepare them ahead of time.</p>
<p><b>5. Mercenary (Adjective) : लालच : having or marked by an eager and often selfish desire especially for material possessions</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> greedy, avaricious, acquisitive</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> altruistic, charitable</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> She's interested in him for purely mercenary reasons.</p>	<p><b>10. Shirker (Noun) : कामचोर : one who deliberately avoids work or duty</b></p> <p><b>Synonyms:</b> idler, lingerer, sluggard</p> <p><b>Antonyms:</b> doer, hustler</p> <p><b>Example Sentence:</b> There is no room in our organization for shirkers.</p>
