

**VOCABULARY FOR 28 MARCH 2023**

<b>1-Robust(Adjective) : मज़बूत : Strong and healthy; full of vigor; hardy</b>
<b>Synonyms :</b> Sturdy , Rugged
<b>Antonyms :</b> Insipid , Frail
<b>Example Sentence:</b> His robust strength made him survive the disaster.
<b>2-Curtailing(Verb) : संक्षिप्त करना: To reduce or limit something</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Lesson , Decrease
<b>Antonyms:</b> Lengthen , Increase
<b>Example Sentence:</b> In his inability to force this nameless woman to marry him, he faced a definite curtailment of his former power.
<b>3--Caters(Verb) : आवश्यकताओं का ध्यान रखना : To provide all the things that they need or want.</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Regale , Serve
<b>Antonyms :</b> Disappoint
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The awards ceremony will be a catered event.
<b>4-Tapestry(Noun) : कपड़ा जिसमें चित्र बने हो : A heavy handwoven reversible textile used for hangings, curtains,</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Drapery
<b>Antonyms:</b> Natural object
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The interior contains tapestry of the 16th century and other works of art.
<b>5--Beguiling(Adjective) : आकर्षक : Agreeably or charmingly attractive or pleasing</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Captivate , Mesmerize
<b>Antonyms :</b> Bore , Repel
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They were beguiled into thinking they'd heard the whole story

<b>6-Clutch(Verb) : पकड़ना: To take or try to take hold of something tightly, usually in fear, worry, or pain</b>
<b>Synonyms :</b> Clamp , Grasp
<b>Antonyms :</b> Loosen , Release
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The child clutched her mother's hand firmly.
<b>7-Contend(Verb): संघर्ष करना : To struggle in opposition</b>
<b>Synonyms :</b> Struggle , Protest
<b>Antonyms :</b> Peaceful , Agreeable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The team is expected to contend for the championship this year.
<b>8-Decennial(Adjective) : दस वर्ष का: Recurring every ten years</b>
<b>Synonyms :</b> Decaversary
<b>Example Sentence:</b> For the 2000 decennial census, that will no longer be the case.
<b>9-Disparity(Noun) : असमानता : A difference, especially one that is caused by unfair treatment</b>
<b>Synonyms :</b> Discrepancy , Distinction
<b>Antonyms :</b> Parity , Similarity
<b>Example Sentence:</b> There are also big disparities in pay.
<b>10-Purported : विकट: (used about a situation, news, etc.) unpleasant or worrying</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Stern , Aloof
<b>Antonyms :</b> Amiable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> His face looked grim, and we knew his news wouldn't be good.
