

VOCABULARY FOR 15 APRIL 2023

1-Robust(Adjective) : मज़बूत : Strong and healthy; full of vigor; hardy
Synonyms : Sturdy , Rugged
Antonyms : Insipid , Frail
Example Sentence: His robust strength made him survive the disaster.
2-Curtailing(Verb) : संक्षिप्त करना: To reduce or limit something
Synonyms: Lesson , Decrease
Antonyms: Lengthen , Increase
Example Sentence: In his inability to force this nameless woman to marry him, he faced a definite curtailment of his former power.
3--Caters(Verb) : आवश्यकताओं का ध्यान रखना : To provide all the things that they need or want.
Synonyms: Regale , Serve
Antonyms : Disappoint
Example Sentence: The awards ceremony will be a catered event.
4-Tapestry(Noun) : कपड़ा जिसमें चित्र बने हो : A heavy handwoven reversible textile used for hangings, curtains,
Synonyms: Drapery
Antonyms: Natural object
Example Sentence: The interior contains tapestry of the 16th century and other works of art.
5--Beguiling(Adjective) : आकर्षक : Agreeably or charmingly attractive or pleasing
Synonyms: Captivate , Mesmerize
Antonyms : Bore , Repel
Example Sentence: They were beguiled into thinking they'd heard the whole story

6-Clutch(Verb) : पकड़ना: To take or try to take hold of something tightly, usually in fear, worry, or pain
Synonyms : Clamp , Grasp
Antonyms : Loosen , Release
Example Sentence: The child clutched her mother's hand firmly.
7-Contend(Verb): संघर्ष करना : To struggle in opposition
Synonyms : Struggle , Protest
Antonyms : Peaceful , Agreeable
Example Sentence: The team is expected to contend for the championship this year.
8-Decennial(Adjective) : दस वर्ष का: Recurring every ten years
Synonyms : Decaversary
Example Sentence: For the 2000 decennial census, that will no longer be the case.
9-Disparity(Noun) : असमानता : A difference, especially one that is caused by unfair treatment
Synonyms : Discrepancy , Distinction
Antonyms : Parity , Similarity
Example Sentence: There are also big disparities in pay.
10-Purported : विकट: (used about a situation, news, etc.) unpleasant or worrying
Synonyms: Stern , Aloof
Antonyms : Amiable
Example Sentence: His face looked grim, and we knew his news wouldn't be good.
