1. TRANSITIONAL (ADJECTIVE): (माध्यमिक): intermediate
Synonyms: middle, midway
Antonyms: initial
Example Sentence: A transitional government had been appointed.
2. ATTEST (VERB): (संपुष्टि करना): certify
Synonyms: corroborate, confirm
Antonyms: disprove
Example Sentence The witnesses must attest and sign the will in the testator's presence
3. AMEND (VERB): (संशोधन करना): revise
Synonyms: alter, change
Antonyms: deteriorate
Example Sentence: The rule was amended to apply only to non-members.
4. EXPEDITE (VERB): (शीघ्रता करना): speed up
Synonyms: accelerate, hurry
Antonyms: delay
Example Sentence He promised to expedite economic reforms.
5. ABROGATE (VERB): (अभिनिषेध करना): repudiate
Synonyms: revoke, repeal
Antonyms: institute
Example Sentence: Engagements were binding, which ended up abrogating a particular engagement
6. ISOLATION (NOUN): (एकांत): separation

Synonyms: segregation, quarantine
Antonyms: contact
Example Sentence: Isolation from family and friends may also contribute to anxiety.
7. RIGOROUS (ADJECTIVE): (सख्त): strict
Synonyms: severe, stern
Antonyms: lax
Example Sentence: Rigorous controls on mergers are needed
8. DEMOLITION (NOUN): (विध्वंस): destruction
Synonyms: knocking down, flattening
Antonyms: construction
Example Sentence: The monument was saved from demolition.
9. RETAIN (NOUN): (रखे रहना): keep
Synonyms: hold on to, hold fast to
Antonyms: give up
Example Sentence: Labour retained the seat.
10. STEEP (ADJECTIVE): (बहुत ढालवाँ): precipitous
Synonyms: sheer, abrupt
Antonyms: gentle
Example Sentence: She pushed the bike up the steep hill.
