1.FOUL (ADJECTIVE): (विकर्षक): disgusting
Synonyms: revolting, repellent
Antonyms: fragrant
Example Sentence: A foul odour troubled us all.
2UNBRIDLED(ADJECTIVE): (निरंकुश): unrestrained
Synonyms: unconstrained uncontrolled
Antonyms: restrained
Example Sentence: I felt a moment of unbridled ambition.
3. VAGUELY (ADVERB): (अनिश्चित रूप से): roughly
Synonyms: more or less, approximately
Antonyms: exactly
Example Sentence: She vaguely remembered talking to him once.
4.DRACONIAN(ADJECTIVE): (कठोर): harsh
Synonyms: severe, strict
Antonyms: mild
Example Sentence: He criticized the draconian measures taken by the police to control the crowd.
5.INVENTIVENESS (NOUN): (रचनात्मकता): creativity
Synonyms: originality, innovation
Antonyms: unimaginativeness

Example Sentence: We all loved the inventiveness of the staging.
6.AGGRIEVED(ADJECTIVE): (क्रोधित): resentful
Synonyms: affronted, indignant
Antonyms: pleased
Example Sentence: They were aggrieved at the outcome.
7.REPUGNANT(ADJECTIVE): (घृणित): abhorrent
Synonyms: revolting, repulsive
Antonyms: attractive
Example Sentence: Cannibalism seems repugnant to us.
8. DEFAMATION (NOUN): (अपयश): libel
Synonyms: slander, calumny
Antonyms: commendation
Example Sentence: She sued him for defamation.
9. SOUR (ADJECTIVE): (चिड़चिड़ा): nasty
Synonyms: resentful, embittered
Antonyms: pleasant
Example Sentence: He gave her a sour look.
10. FLOUT (VERB): (अवज्ञा करना): defy
Synonyms: go against, scorn
Antonyms: observe
Example Sentence: The advertising code is being flouted.
