<b>1. BLUNT (ADJECTIVE): (स्पष्टवादी): frank</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> straightforward, plain-spoken
<b>Antonyms:</b> subtle
<b>Example Sentence:</b> What he said was a blunt statement of fact.
<b>2. FORMIDABLE (ADJECTIVE): (दुर्जेय): intimidating</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> forbidding, redoubtable
<b>Antonyms:</b> comforting
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Competition from established businesses can be formidable.
<b>3. JUBILATION (NOUN): (आनंद): joy</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> exultation, triumph
<b>Antonyms:</b> despondency
<b>Example Sentence:</b> We all witnessed unbelievable scenes of jubilation.
<b>4. DISINGENUOUS (ADJECTIVE): (कपटी): dishonest</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> deceitful, underhand
<b>Antonyms:</b> ingenuous
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was being somewhat disingenuous as well as cynical.
<b>5. IRREFUTABLE (ADJECTIVE): (अखंडनीय): indisputable</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> undeniable, unquestionable
<b>Antonyms:</b> unreliable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It is a profound thought and, I believe, an irrefutable one.
<b>6. SHAMBLE (VERB): (फेर-बदल करना): shuffle</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> lumber, totter
<b>Antonyms:</b> run
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He shambled off down the corridor.

<b>7. FIERCE (ADJECTIVE): (प्रचंड): powerful</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> strong, violent
<b>Antonyms:</b> gentle
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Fierce storms lashed the country.
<b>8. BENIGN (ADJECTIVE): (शीतोष्ण): temperate</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> mild, gentle
<b>Antonyms:</b> harsh
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The climate becomes more benign as we move nearer to the Black Sea.
<b>9. THWART (VERB): (विफल करना): foil</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> frustrate, balk
<b>Antonyms:</b> assist
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She did all she could to thwart his plans.
<b>10. ESCHEW (VERB): (त्याग करना): give up</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> forgo, forswear
<b>Antonyms:</b> indulge in
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The minister appealed to the crowd to eschew violence.
