<b>1.ABROGATE(VERB):(अभिनिषेधकरना):</b> repudiate
<b>Synonyms:</b> revoke, repeal
<b>Antonyms:</b> institute
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The ministry proposed to abrogate the dated electoral law.
<b>2.RESOUNDING(ADJECTIVE):(गुंजयमान):</b> reverberant
<b>Synonyms:</b> reverberating, resonant
<b>Antonyms:</b> faint
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I gave him a resounding smack across the face because of his.
<b>3.DEMOLITION(NOUN):(विध्वंस):</b> destruction
<b>Synonyms:</b> flattening, razing
<b>Antonyms:</b> construction
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The monument was thankfully saved from demolition.
<b>4.DISCERNIBLE(ADJECTIVE):(प्रत्यक्ष):</b> visible
<b>Synonyms:</b> detectable, noticeable
<b>Antonyms:</b> imperceptible
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The scandal had no discernible effect on his career.
<b>5. GLOOM (NOUN): (उदासी):</b> depression
<b>Synonyms:</b> despondency, dejection
<b>Antonyms:</b> happiness
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Last year was of economic gloom for the car industry.
<b>6. SHUN (VERB): (किनारा करना):</b> avoid
<b>Synonyms:</b> evade, eschew

<b>Antonyms:</b> accept
<b>Example Sentence:</b> After his divorce he found himself being shunned by many of his former friends.
<b>7.ARGUABLE(ADJECTIVE):(तर्कयोग्य):</b> debatable
<b>Synonyms:</b> disputable, questionable
<b>Antonyms:</b> certain
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He made a highly arguable assumption.
<b>8.OBNOXIOUS(ADJECTIVE):(अप्रिय):</b> unpleasant
<b>Synonyms:</b> disagreeable, nasty
<b>Antonyms:</b> delightful
<b>Example Sentence:</b> We left to avoid the obnoxious music.
<b>9.MULTITUDE(ADJECTIVE):(भीड़):</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> gathering, assembly
<b>Antonyms:</b> elite
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Placing ultimate political power in the hands of the multitude is debatable.
<b>10.RENEGE(VERB):(वापसजाना):</b> go back on
<b>Synonyms:</b> break, back out of
<b>Antonyms:</b> keep
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They have reneged on their promises to us.
