.1 CONFRONT (VERB): (मुकाबला करना): tackle
Synonyms: get to grips with, address
Antonyms: avoid
Example Sentence: The best thing you can do in an embarrassing situation is to confront it
.2.RIFE (ADJECTIVE): (फैला हुआ): widespread
Synonyms: general, common
Antonyms: scarce, unknown
Example Sentence: Male chauvinism was rife in medicine.
3.EXACERBATE(VERB):(बदतरहोना): aggrate
Synonyms: worsen, inflame
Antonyms: calm
Example Sentence: Their silly attempts to resolve their misunderstandings exacerbated matters.
4.POISED (ADJECTIVE): (शांतचित्त): self-possessed
Synonyms: self-assured, composed
Antonyms: excited
Example Sentence: Not every day you saw that poised, competent kid distressed
.5.PURSUE (VERB): (संचालित करना): conduct
Synonyms: undertake, follow
Antonyms: give up
Example Sentence: We shall not pursue the matter any further.
6. FAIRLY (ADVERB): (युक्तिपूर्वक): reasonably

Synonyms: passably, satisfactorily
Antonyms: insufficiently
Example Sentence: I was fairly certain she had nothing to do with the affair
.7.MENACE (VERB): (खतरे में डालना): threaten
Synonyms: jeopardize, imperil
Antonyms: friendly
Example Sentence: Africa's elephants are still menaced by poaching
.8.DREADFUL (ADJECTIVE): (भयानक): terrible
Synonyms: frightful, horrible
Antonyms: mild
Example Sentence: He survived a dreadful accident.
9. PSYCHE (NOUN): (मानस): soul
Synonyms: spirit, life force
Antonyms: body
Example Sentence: Her work touches something profound in the human psyche.
10.SPORADIC(ADJECTIVE):(छिटपुट): occasional
Synonyms: infrequent, irregular
Antonyms: frequent
Example Sentence: Sporadic fighting broke out.
