<b>1. EXPEDITE : (VERB):</b> (जल्दी करना): <b>speed up</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> accelerate, hurry
<b>Antonyms:</b> delay
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I expedited the completion of my report.
<b>2. DISPEL : (VERB):</b> (दूर करना): <b>banish</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> eliminate, dismiss
<b>Antonyms:</b> engender
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The brightness of the day did nothing to dispel my sadness.
<b>3. FIERCE : (ADJECTIVE):</b> (प्रचंड): <b>powerful</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> strong, violent
<b>Antonyms:</b> gentle
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Fierce storms lashed the country.
<b>4. DISMAY : (NOUN):</b> (त्रस्त करना): <b>appal</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> horrify, shock
<b>Antonyms:</b> encourage
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was dismayed by the U-turn in policy.
<b>5. IMPULSE : (NOUN):</b> (आवेग): <b>wildness</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> spontaneity, recklessness
<b>Antonyms:</b> premeditation
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was solely a woman of impulse.
<b>6. AGITATION : (NOUN):</b> (व्याकुलता): <b>anxiety</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> perturbation, disquiet
<b>Antonyms:</b> calmness

<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was wringing her hands in agitation.
<b>7. ENTIRETY : (NOUN):</b> (संपूर्णता): <b>whole</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> sum, total
<b>Antonyms:</b> part
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She would have to stay in her room for the entirety of the weekend.
<b>8. DREAD : (NOUN):</b> (भय): <b>fear</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> apprehension, trepidation
<b>Antonyms:</b> confidence
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The thought of returning to London filled her with dread.
<b>9. AGGRIEVED (ADJECTIVE):</b> (क्रोधित): <b>resentful</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> affronted, indignant
<b>Antonyms:</b> pleased
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They were aggrieved at the outcome.
<b>10. SHAMBLE (VERB):</b> (फेर-बदल करना): <b>shuffle</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> lumber, totter
<b>Antonyms:</b> run
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He shambled off down the corridor.
