

VOCABULARY FOR 19 JUNE 2023

1. SEVER (VERB): (तोड़ना): break off
Synonyms: discontinue, suspend
Antonyms: maintain
Example Sentence: The notice itself may be sufficient to sever the joint tenancy.
2. EMINENT (ADJECTIVE): (प्रसिद्ध): illustrious
Synonyms: distinguished, renowned
Antonyms: unimportant
Example Sentence: He is one of the world's most eminent statisticians.
3. EVINCE (VERB): (प्रकट करना): reveal
Synonyms: show, manifest
Antonyms: conceal
Example Sentence: The news stories evinced the usual mixture of sympathy and satisfaction.
4. REPUDIATION (NOUN): (अस्वीकृति): rejection
Synonyms: renunciation, abandonment
Antonyms: confirmation
Example Sentence: The breach is not so serious as to amount to a repudiation of the whole contract.
5. COMMUNICATIVE (ADJECTIVE): (संवादाशील): forthcoming
Synonyms: expansive, informative
Antonyms: uncommunicative
Example Sentence: Lew was a very communicative chap.

6. GRIM (ADJECTIVE): (अरूचिकर): stern
Synonyms: forbidding, uninviting
Antonyms: amiable
Example Sentence: His grim expression keeps people away from him.
7. DISPOSE (VERB): (फेंक देना): throw away
Synonyms: throw out, cast out
Antonyms: retain
Example Sentence: The waste is disposed of in the North Sea.
8. AGITATION (NOUN): (व्याकुलता): anxiety
Synonyms: perturbation, disquiet
Antonyms: calmness
Example Sentence: She was wringing her hands in agitation.
9. SPUR (NOUN): (प्रोत्साहन): stimulus
Synonyms: incentive encouragement
Antonyms: disincentive, discouragement
Example Sentence: Wars act as a spur to practical invention.
10. EVASIVE (ADJECTIVE): (टाल-मटोल वाला): prevaricating
Synonyms: elusive, ambiguous
Antonyms: frank
Example Sentence: She was evasive about her phone number.
