Antonyms: scheming

Example Sentence: It was an artless literary

masterpiece.

8. PERTURB (VERB): (घबड़ा देना): worry

Synonyms: upset, unsettle

Antonyms: reassure

Example Sentence: News of the arrest

perturbed her greatly.

CAPRICIOUS (ADJECTIVE):

(मौजी): fickle

Synonyms: inconstant, changeable

Antonyms: stable

10. DENT (VERB): (घटाना): diminish

Synonyms: reduce, lessen
