<b>1. INVOKE (VERB): (तलब करना): cite</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> adduce instance
<b>Antonyms:</b> waive
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The outdated defence of insanity is rarely invoked in England.
<b>2. PROMINENT (ADJECTIVE): (महत्वपूर्ण): important</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> well known, leading
<b>Antonyms:</b> unimportant
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was a prominent member of the city council.
<b>3. DISSENT (NOUN): (असहमति): disagreement</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> argument, demur
<b>Antonyms:</b> agreement, acceptance
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He did everything in his power to suppress political dissent.
<b>4. DETRACT (VERB): (कम करना): belittle</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> take away from, diminish
<b>Antonyms:</b> enhance
<b>Example Sentence:</b> These quibbles in no way detract from her achievement.
<b>5. ACRIMONY (NOUN): (अप्रसन्नता): bitterness</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> rancour resentment
<b>Antonyms:</b> goodwill
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The assistant manager dissolved into acrimony.
<b>6. INDUCE (VERB): (मनवाना): persuade</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> convince, get

<b>Antonyms:</b> dissuade
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The pickets induced many workers to stay away.
<b>7. ARTLESS (ADJECTIVE): (अकृत्रिम): natural</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> naïve, simple
<b>Antonyms:</b> scheming
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It was an artless literary masterpiece.
<b>8. PERTURB (VERB): (घबड़ा देना): worry</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> upset, unsettle
<b>Antonyms:</b> reassure
<b>Example Sentence:</b> News of the arrest perturbed her greatly.
<b>9. CAPRICIOUS (ADJECTIVE): (मौजी): fickle</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> inconstant, changeable
<b>Antonyms:</b> stable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It's terrible to feel our livelihood hinges on a capricious boss.
<b>10. DENT (VERB): (घटाना): diminish</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> reduce, lessen
<b>Antonyms:</b> increase
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The disease dented his height.
