1.UNLEASH (VERB): (मुक्त करना): release
Synonyms: free, loose
Antonyms: restrain
Example Sentence: They unleash many birds on this day.
2.RESTORE(VERB):(पुनर्स्थापितकरना): rein state
Synonyms: put back, replace
Antonyms: abolish
Example Sentence: Law and order was eventually restored by riot police.
3.APPOSITE(ADJECTIVE):(उपयुक्त): appropriate
Synonyms: suitable, fitting
Antonyms: inappropriate
Example Sentence: He made an apposite quotation for the project.
4.CENTRALIZE(VERB):(केंद्रीयकरना): concentrate
Synonyms: consolidate, amalgamate
Antonyms: disperse
Example Sentence. One of his first actions was to centralize control of the company's operations.
5.ANTIQUATED(ADJECTIVE):(अप्रचलित): outdated
Synonyms: out of date, outmoded
Antonyms: current
Example Sentence: This building has an antiquated central heating system.
6.GUMPTION(NOUN)(साधनसंपन्नता): initiative
Synonyms: resourcefulness, enterprise

Antonyms: stupidity
Example Sentence: I hope I'd have the gumption not to pretend believing what I did was right.
7.ACQUIT(VERB):(दोषमुक्त करना): absolve
Synonyms: clear, exonerate
Antonyms: convict
Example Sentence: She was acquitted on all counts.
8. DODGE (VERB): (बच निकलना): avoid
Synonyms: evade, shun
Antonyms: face up to, tackle
Example Sentence: He'd caught her dodging fares on the underground.
9.EXQUISITE(ADJECTIVE):(उत्कृष्ट): beautiful
Synonyms: lovely, elegant
Antonyms: crude
Example Sentence: My friend designs exquisite jewellery.
10. FORGO (VERB): (त्यागना): do without
Synonyms: go without, give up
Antonyms: keep
Example Sentence: I wanted to forgo the tea and leave while they could.
