out of a situation

Synonyms: detach, extract

Antonyms: attach, connect

**Example Sentence:** Amay was trying to

extricate himself from official duties.

10.OUTRAGE (NOUN) (रोष): indignation

**Synonyms:** fury, anger

Antonyms: subsidence

Example Sentence: Her voice trembled with

outrage.
