**1. 1. COMMERCIAL (ADJECTIVE):**  
(लाभ के उद्देश्यवाला): Profit-oriented

**Synonyms:** Money-oriented,  
Commercialized

**Antonyms:** Non-profit-making

**Example Sentence:**He hasn't opened a commercial firm.

**2. URGE (VERB): (आग्रह करताहूँ): Encourage**

**Synonyms:** Enjoin, Adjure

**Antonyms:** Discourage

**Example Sentence:**Drawing up outside the house, he urged her inside.

**3. PREVALENCE (NOUN):**  
(प्रसार): Currency

**Synonyms:** Generality, Pervasiveness

**Antonyms:** Infrequency

**Example Sentence:**The prevalence of obesity is there in adults.

**4. APPEASE (VERB): (शांत करना): Conciliate**

**Synonyms:** Placate, Pacify

**Antonyms:** Provoke

**Example Sentence:**Amendments have been added to appease local pressure groups.

**5. DISSIPATE (VERB): (गायब हो जाना): Disappear**

**Synonyms:** Vanish Evaporate

**Antonyms:** Grow

**Example Sentence:**The concern she'd felt for him had wholly dissipated.

**6. TRIAL (NOUN): (परीक्षण): Test**

**Synonyms:** Try-out, Experiment

**Antonyms:** Proven

**Example Sentence:**Clinical trials must verify the truth.

**7 BIZARRE (ADJECTIVE): (विचित्र): Strang**

**Synonyms:** Peculiar, Odd

**Antonyms:** Ordinary

**Example Sentence:**We had to face a bizarre situation.

**8 CAMARADERIE (NOUN):**  
(सौहार्द): Friendshi

**Synonyms:** Comradeship Fellowship,

**Antonyms:** Solitude

**Example Sentence:**Our camaraderie is evident to everyone.

**9. CERTAINTY (NOUN):**  
(निश्चय): Confidence

**Synonyms:** Conviction, Certitude

**Antonyms:** Uncertainty

**Example Sentence:**She knew with certainty that he is dead.

**10. ANIMOSITY (NOUN): (बैर): Antipath**

**Synonyms:** Hostility, Friction

**Antonyms:** Friendship

**Example Sentence:**He no longer felt any animosity towards her.
