predatory.

EXACERBATE (VERB): (खराब

करना): Worsen

Synonyms: Aggravate, Compound

Antonyms: Improve

Example Sentence: Her condition exacerbated on

the flight.

8. RETRACT (VERB): (वापस लेना): Pull in

Synonyms: Draw in, Pull back

Antonyms: Extend

she'd been burnt.

9. REFORM (VERB): (सुधारना): Improve
