<b>1. PEER (NOUN): (सहकर्मी): Fellow</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Co-worker, Compeer
<b>Antonyms:</b> Commoner, Junior
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He has got criticism from his peers.
<b>2. KNOTTY (ADJECTIVE): (जटिल): Troublesome</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Mystifying, Perplexing
<b>Antonyms:</b> Easy, Facile
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It was his knotty idea.
<b>3. DETAIN (VERB): (ज़ब्त करना): Hold</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Seize, Confine
<b>Antonyms:</b> Release
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Customs officers may detain all the goods.
<b>4. EXEMPT (VERB): (छूट देना): Spared</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Free from, Not liable to
<b>Antonyms:</b> Liable to, Subject to
<b>Example Sentence:</b> These patients are exempt from charges.
<b>5. DWINDLE (VERB): (क्षीण होना): Diminish</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Decrease, Reduce
<b>Antonyms:</b> Increase, Flourish
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Traffic has dwindled to a trickle.
<b>6. RECUMBENT (NOUN): (समतल): Flat</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Lying, Horizontal
<b>Antonyms:</b> Erect, Standing

<b>Example Sentence:</b> They are not recumbent, and the hair falling from the head is curled.
<b>7. INCUMBENT (ADJECTIVE): (पदधारी): Present</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Current, Existing
<b>Antonyms:</b> Past, Future
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The incumbent President was defeated.
<b>8. ACCOMMODATIVE (ADJECTIVE): (अनुग्राही): Corrupt</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Adaptative, Adaptive
<b>Antonyms:</b> Maladaptive
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was understanding, accommodative, and always had a solution to all problems.
<b>9. AMELIORATE (VERB): (सुधार होना): Improve</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Enhance, Better
<b>Antonyms:</b> Worsen
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The reform did much to ameliorate living standards.
<b>10. OUTRAGE (NOUN): (उल्लंघन करना): Violate</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> Infuriate, Enrage
<b>Antonyms:</b> Compliment
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The public were outraged at the brutality involved.
