**1. SATISFACTORY (ADJECTIVE):**  
(संतोषजनक): Adequate

**Synonyms:** All right, Acceptable

**Antonyms:** Unsatisfactory

**Example Sentence:** He did not get a satisfactory reply.

**2. ENORMOUSLY (ADVERB): (अत्यंत): Very**

**Synonyms:** Extremely, Exceedingly

**Antonyms:** Moderately

**Example Sentence:** Quality of life varies enormously from one place to another.

**3. VEHEMENCE (NOUN): (जुनून): Passion**

**Synonyms:** Force, Ardor

**Antonyms:** Apathy

**Example Sentence:** There was a lot of vehemence in his reaction.

**4. IMMORAL (ADJECTIVE):**  
(अनैतिक): Unethical

**Synonyms:** Bad, Wrongful

**Antonyms:** Moral

**Example Sentence:** Her behaviour was seemingly immoral.

**5. ACCREDIT (VERB): (मान्यता देना): Recognize**

**Synonyms:** License, Authorize

**Antonyms:** Ban

**Example Sentence:** Institutions that do not meet the standards will not be accredited for teacher training.

**6. THRIVE (VERB): (फलना-फूलना): Flourish**

**Synonyms:** Prosper, Surgeon

**Antonyms:** Decline

**Example Sentence:** Education groups thrive on organization.

**7. LAMENT (VERB): (विलाप करना): Mourn**

**Synonyms:** Sorrow, Wail

**Antonyms:** Celebrate

**Example Sentence:** He was lamenting the death of his infant daughter.

**8. PLUNGE (NOUN): (गिरावट): Fall**

**Synonyms:** Drop, Tumble

**Antonyms:** Rise

**Example Sentence:** The central bank declared a 76% plunge in its profits.

**9. DIVINE (ADJECTIVE): (मनोरम): Lovely**

**Synonyms:** Handsome, Beautiful

**Antonyms:** Mundane

**Example Sentence:** Her face had the most divine smile.

**10. OPTIMISM (NOUN): (आशावाद): Hope**

**Synonyms:** Confidence, Buoyancy

**Antonyms:** Pessimism

**Example Sentence:** The talks had been amicable and there were grounds for optimism.
