Example Sentence: It is questionable whether any of these exceptions is genuine.

7. SHELVE (VERB): (टालना): lay aside

Synonyms: pigeonhole, stay

Antonyms: carry out

Example Sentence: Plans to reopen the

school have been shelved.

8. VIGILANT (ADJECTIVE):

Synonyms: observant, sharp-eyed

Antonyms: negligent

spotted by vigilant neighbours.

9. EXALT (VERB): (प्रशंसा करना): glorify

Synonyms: extol, praise
