Example Sentence: Both tried to behave as

if nothing untoward had happened.

6. DISENGAGE (VERB): (अलग

करना): remove

Synonyms: detach, disentangle

Antonyms: attach

Example Sentence: I disengaged his hand

from mine.

7. SLY (ADJECTIVE): (धूर्त): cunning

Synonyms: crafty, clever

Antonyms: honest, artless

Example Sentence: She asked me out with

a sly smile.

8. REPUDIATION (NOUN):

(अस्वीकृति): rejection

Synonyms: renunciation, abandonment

Antonyms: confirmation

Example Sentence: The breach is not so

serious as to amount to a repudiation of the

whole contract.

9. NEGATE (VERB): (अमान्य

करना): invalidate

Synonyms: nullify, neutralize

Antonyms: confirm

Example Sentence: Alcohol negates the

effects of the drug.

10. UNPREMEDITATED (ADJECTIVE):

(अनियोजित): unplanned

Synonyms: spontaneous, unprepared

Antonyms: premeditated

Example Sentence:It was a totally

unpremeditated attack.
