<b>1.EXACERBATE (VERB): (बदतर करना): aggravate</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> worsen, inflame
<b>Antonyms:</b> calm
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Excessive or hard exercise can exacerbate pain.
<b>2.INEXPLICABLE (ADJECTIVE): (अकथनीय): unaccountable</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> unexplainable, incomprehensible
<b>Antonyms:</b> understandable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> For some inexplicable reason her mind went completely blank.
<b>3.DRACONIAN (ADJECTIVE): (कड़ा): harsh</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> strict, extreme
<b>Antonyms:</b> mild
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Draconian measures have been taken to control population growth.
<b>4.INCARCERATE (VERB): (बंदी बनाना): imprison</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> jail, lock up
<b>Antonyms:</b> free
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Many are incarcerated for property offences.
<b>5. EXUBERANCE (NOUN): (उत्साह): ebullience</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> buoyancy, cheerfulness
<b>Antonyms:</b> gloom
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He has a sense of youthful exuberance.
<b>6. SLUMP (NOUN): (मंदी): recession</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> depression, slowdown

<b>Antonyms:</b> boom
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He had survived a world war and a slump.
<b>7.VINDICATE (NOUN): (बरी करना): acquit</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> clear, absolve
<b>Antonyms:</b> convict
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Hospital staff were vindicated by the inquest verdict.
<b>8.HAIL (NOUN): (अभिवादन): greeting</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> hello, hallo
<b>Antonyms:</b> farewell
<b>Example Sentence:</b> My sleepy hail was met by a shout.
<b>9.ANOMALOUS (ADJECTIVE): (असामान्य): abnormal</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> atypical, non-typical
<b>Antonyms:</b> normal
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He went through an anomalous situation.
<b>10. DISCREPANCY (NOUN): (विसंगति): inconsistency</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> difference, disparit
<b>Antonyms:</b> similarity
<b>Example Sentence:</b> There's a discrepancy between your account and his.
