<b>1. FISHY (ADJECTIVE):</b> <b>(संदेहजनक): dubious</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> doubtful, suspicious
<b>Antonyms:</b> truthful, aboveboard
<b>Example Sentence</b> I am convinced there is something fishy.
<b>2. KNOTTY (ADJECTIVE):</b> <b>(जटिल): troublesome</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> mystifying, perplexing
<b>Antonyms:</b> easy, facile
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It was his knotty idea
<b>.3. KNAVE (NOUN): (दुष्ट): fraud</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> miscreant, rogue
<b>Antonyms:</b> hero, angel
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He is known as a notorious knave of this area.
<b>4. LUDICROUS (ADJECTIVE):</b> <b>(ऊटपटांग): absurd</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> bizarre, comical
<b>Antonyms:</b> normal, ordinary
<b>Example Sentence:</b> It was a ludicrous statement made by her.
<b>5. ACCOMMODATIVE (ADJECTIVE):</b> <b>(अनुग्राही): corrupt</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> adaptative, adaptive
<b>Antonyms:</b> maladaptive
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was understanding, accommodative, and always had a solution to all problems.
<b>6. CONSENT (NOUN): (सहमति): assent</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> agreement, permission

<b>Antonyms:</b> dissent, disagreement
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Change was made without the consent.
<b>7. CULMINATION (NOUN):</b> <b>(परिणति): climax</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> peak, pinnacle
<b>Antonyms:</b> nadir
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The deal marked the culmination of years of negotiation
<b>.8. PEER (NOUN): (सहकर्मी): fellow</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> co-worker, compeer
<b>Antonyms:</b> commoner, junior
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He has got criticism from his peers.
<b>9. CODIFY (VERB): (संहिताबद्ध करना): organize</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> systematize, arrange
<b>Antonyms:</b> expunge, abrogate
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The statutes have codified certain branches of common law.
<b>10. KUDOS (NOUN): (प्रशंसा): praise</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> esteem, applause
<b>Antonyms:</b> dishonour, denunciation
<b>Example Sentence:</b> They were given kudos for winning.
