<b>1.CASTIGATE (VERB): (आलोचना करना): reprimand</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> rebuke, admonish
<b>Antonyms:</b> praise
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She was castigated for not setting a good example.
<b>2.THRIVE (VERB): (फलना-फूलना): flourish</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> prosper, burgeon
<b>Antonyms:</b> decline
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Education groups thrive on organization.
<b>3.MORIBUND (ADJECTIVE): (मरणसन्न): dying</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> expiring, at death's door
<b>Antonyms:</b> thriving
<b>Example Sentence:</b> On examination she was moribund and dehydrated.
<b>4.RECONCILE (VERB): (समाधान करना): reunite</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> pacify, appease
<b>Antonyms:</b> estrange
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He sought my advice on how to reconcile the conflict.
<b>5.FABLED (ADJECTIVE): (कल्पित): legendary</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> mythical, mythic
<b>Antonyms:</b> real
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The movie mentioned the fabled Arendelle kingdom.
<b>6.DENT (VERB): (घटाना): diminish</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> reduce, lessen
<b>Antonyms:</b> increase
<b>Example Sentence:</b> This neither deterred him nor dented his enthusiasm.

<b>7.FOUL (ADJECTIVE): (विकर्षक): disgusting</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> revolting, repellent
<b>Antonyms:</b> fragrant
<b>Example Sentence:</b> A foul odour troubled us all.
<b>8.CONVALESCE (VERB) (निरामय होना):recuperate</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> recover, improve
<b>Antonyms:</b> deteriorate
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He spent eight months convalescing after the stroke.
<b>9.IMPOVERISH (VERB): (शक्तिहीन करना): weaken</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> sap, exhaust
<b>Antonyms:</b> strengthen
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The soil was impoverished by burning.
<b>10. REPUDIATE (VERB): (अस्वीकार करना): reject</b>
<b>Synonyms:</b> renounce, abandon
<b>Antonyms:</b> embrace
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She has repudiated policies associated with previous party leaders..
