<b>1.FORMIDABLE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (दुर्जेय): intimidating
<b>Synonyms:</b> forbidding, redoubtable
<b>Antonyms:</b> comforting
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Competition from established businesses can be formidable.
<b>2.VAGUELY (ADVERB):</b> (अनिश्चित रूप से): roughly
<b>Synonyms:</b> more or less, approximately
<b>Antonyms:</b> exactly
<b>Example Sentence:</b> She vaguely remembered talking to him once.
<b>3.UNBRIDLED (ADJECTIVE):</b> (निरंकुश): unrestrained
<b>Synonyms:</b> unconstrained uncontrolled
<b>Antonyms:</b> restrained
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I felt a moment of unbridled ambition.
<b>4.IRRITANT (NOUN):</b> (चिढ़): annoyance
<b>Synonyms:</b> irritation, pinprick
<b>Antonyms:</b> help
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The reasons for his irritant are now well known.
<b>5.PLAINTIVE (ADJECTIVE):</b> (शोकाकुल): mournful
<b>Synonyms:</b> sad, wistful
<b>Antonyms:</b> cheerful
<b>Example Sentence:</b> The sad news of their grandmother's death left the room full of plaintive cries.

<b>6. RAMPANT (ADJECTIVE):</b> (अनियंत्रित): uncontrolled
<b>Synonyms:</b> unrestrained, unchecked
<b>Antonyms:</b> controlled
<b>Example Sentence:</b> Political violence was rampant in our area.
<b>7.ACCLAIM (VERB):</b> (प्रशंसा करना): praise
<b>Synonyms:</b> applaud, cheer
<b>Antonyms:</b> criticise
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was acclaimed for his amazing work.
<b>8.DODGY (ADJECTIVE):</b> (बेईमान): dishonest
<b>Synonyms:</b> deceitful, dubious
<b>Antonyms:</b> honest
<b>Example Sentence:</b> I had to deal with a dodgy second-hand car salesman.
<b>9.IGNOMINIOUS (ADJECTIVE):</b> (अकीर्तिकर): humiliating
<b>Synonyms:</b> undignified, embarrassing
<b>Antonyms:</b> glorious
<b>Example Sentence</b> No other party risked ignominious defeat.
<b>10.GREGARIOUS (ADJECTIVE):</b> (सुसामाजिक): social
<b>Synonyms:</b> sociable, companionable
<b>Antonyms:</b> unsociable
<b>Example Sentence:</b> He was a popular and gregarious man.
